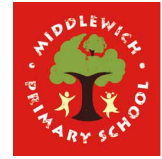

Pupil Premium Impact Statement 2015 – 2016 National Comparators

The information below compares the progress and attainment of those pupils who attend Middlewich Primary School who are in receipt of pupil premium funding, to all the pupils across the nation who do **not** have pupil premium (National Other).

Progress is the difference between the national progress score for all pupils, which is set at zero, and the average progress score of the group.

Attainment is shown as the percentage of pupils who achieved the expected standard in the assessment in comparison to every child nationally who does not receive this funding.
