Sports Premium Impact 2013-2014 **Middlewich Primary School £9550**

What impact did this spending have?

Buying into Middlewich Schools Partnership has meant the school has been invited to all sporting events in local area. The funding has helped release members of staff to train and escort children to sporting events such as a World Cup themed girls football tournament, Crewe Alex Football League Tournament, a Middlewich swimming gala. A cricket coach was also employed in preparation for a tournament.

In addition to the two hours of PE delivered by qualified coaches from Multiflex, all children had the opportunity to experience another sport. Middlewich High School PE staff provided model lessons to introduce children in all year groups to a new sport and then worked alongside Middlewich Primary School staff to deliver a six week scheme of work. Children were introduced to badminton, hockey or tag rugby.

Money was also spent on updating / improving the materials used to deliver the PE Curriculum. As a result, the school is now well stocked for all the sports and activities planned for the year ahead.

Sporting Opportunities.

Children at Middlewich Primary School have had the opportunities to take part in the following after school sporting activities:

Staff led clubs: Tag rugby, football, cricket, rounders, netball, fencing.

Multiflex led clubs: Dance, cross-country, basketball, KS1 football, gymnastics.
