The Writing Area

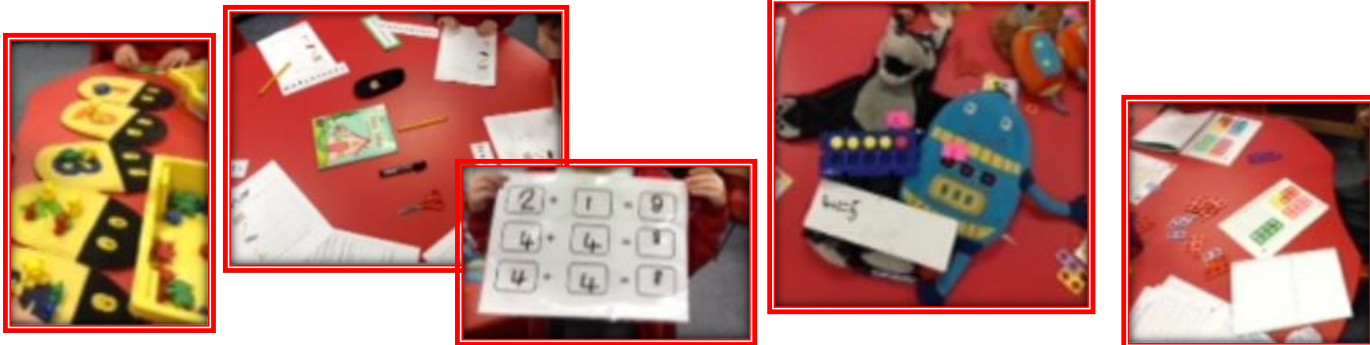
You will learn how to be a super writer in reception. You can always practise in the writing areas.

Can you count? You will learn all about numbers and counting in the maths areas.



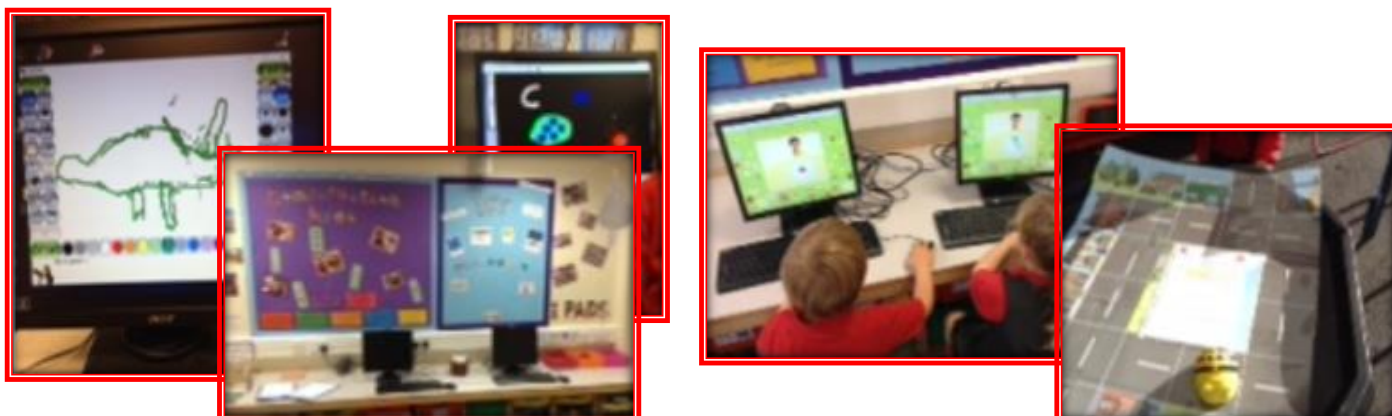
Construction Activities

There are lots of chances to practise your computing skills on the computers in the classrooms, ipads and even beebots. Look at some of the work children have done on them:





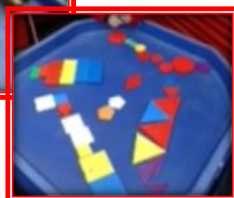
Creative Area

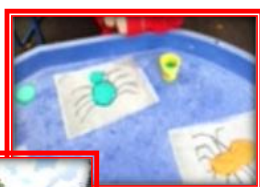
The Outdoor Classroom

Every morning you will have snack time. You will be given milk or water and a fruit snack so that you keep nice and healthy.

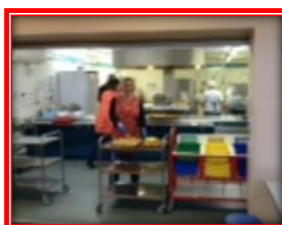
Playtimes
