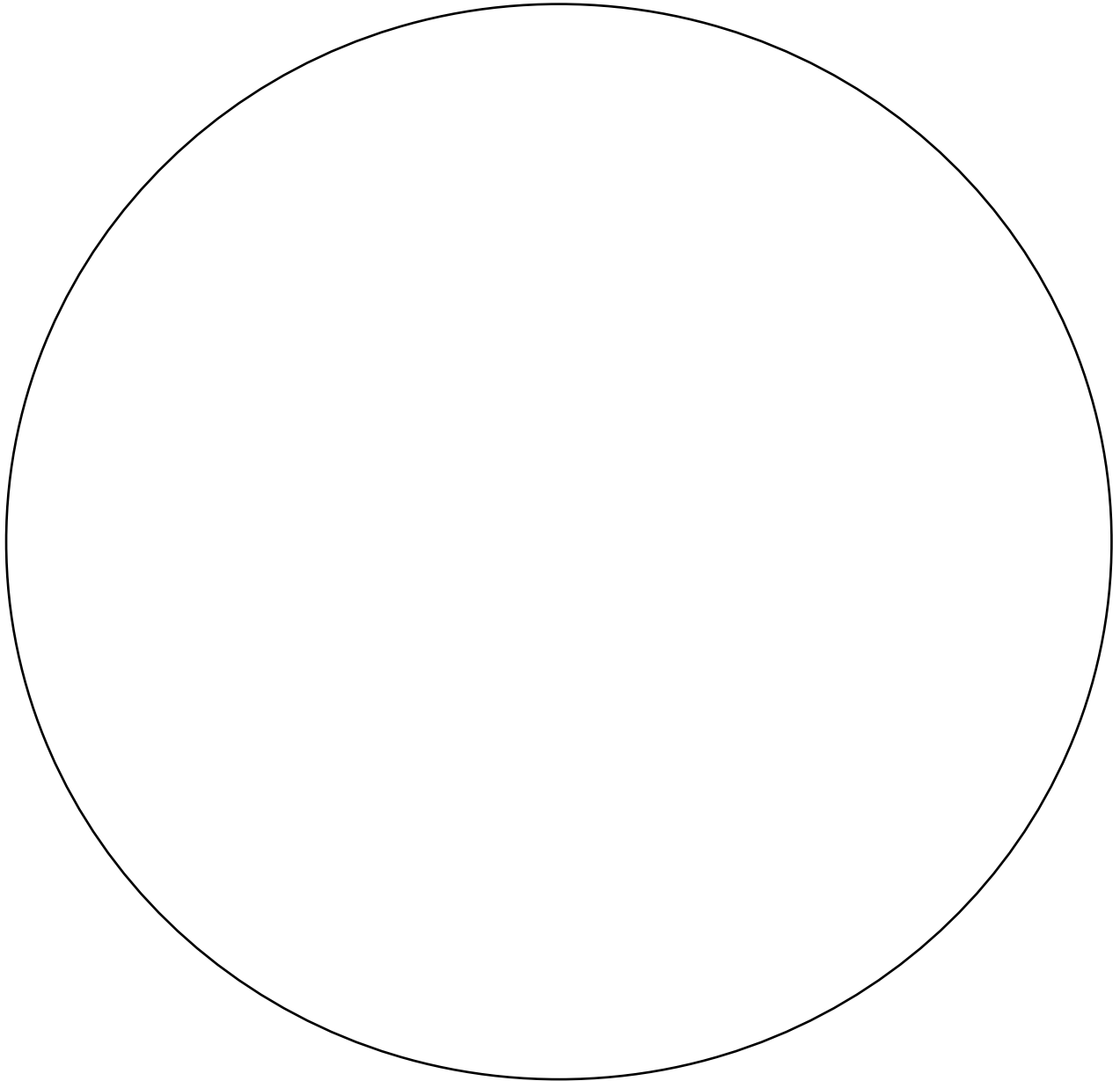

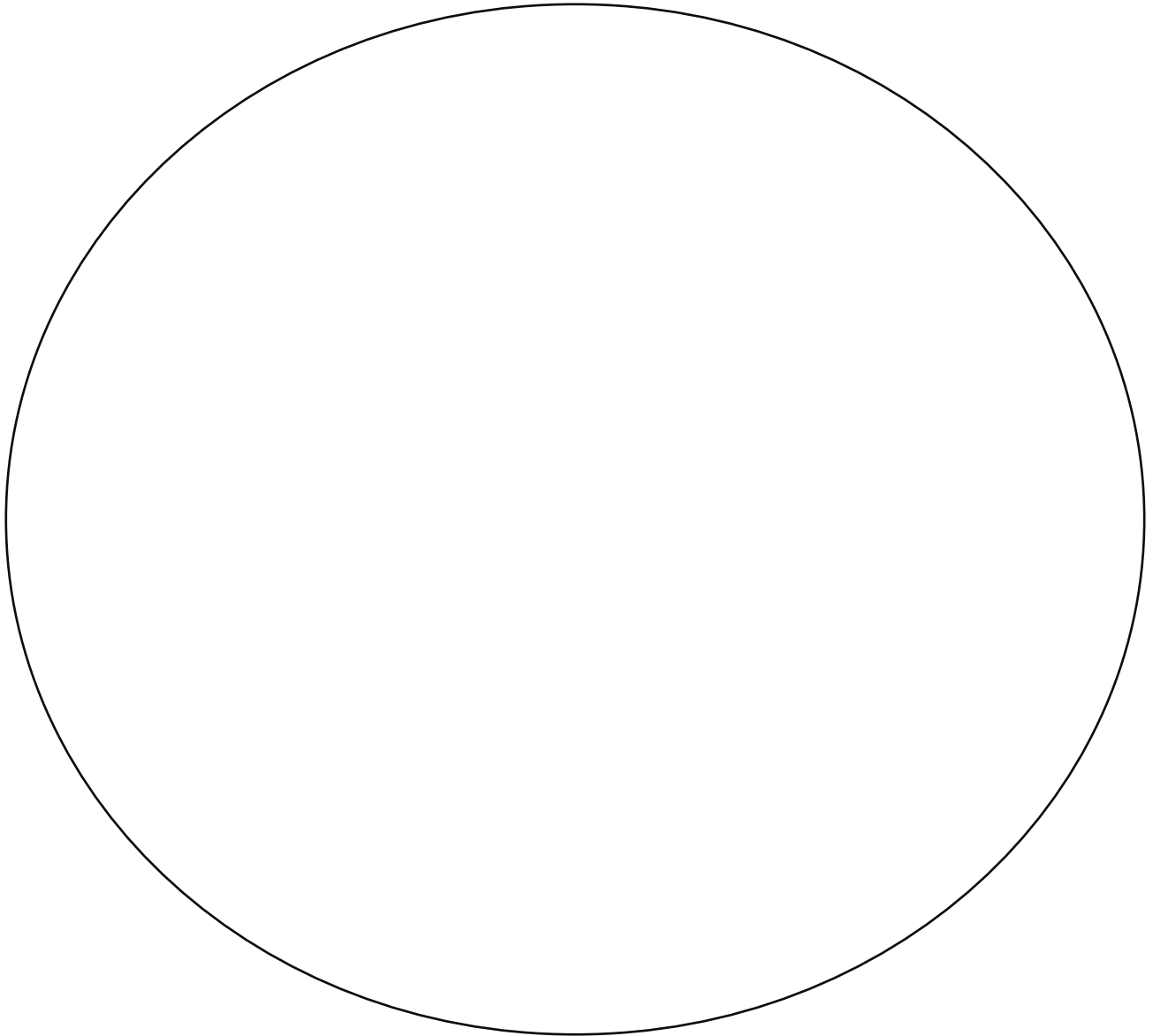


My favourite story
