- **The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe:** write a setting description, character description and a fantasy retell.
- **Clever Polly and the Stupid Wolf:** write a dialogue between two characters, instructions on how to outsmart a wolf and a fantasy retell.
- **Arete retell:** write a retelling of our own experiences at the Arete Centre.
- **Bandoola:** write a non-fiction piece of writing that provides information on Myanmar, non-chronological report on elephants and retelling the events of Bandoola's heroic journey.

## Science

- **Living things and their habitats:** recap the living things discovered in the school grounds from autumn and compare to spring.
- **Sound:** compare and explore pitch and volume through different investigations.
