- **The Piano** – Watch the short film ‘The Piano’ by Aidan Gibbons, discussing the themes and use of flashbacks and images. Write a narrative piece, incorporating emotive devices and flashbacks to move the story forward.
- **When We Walked on the Moon** – Read the non-fiction text by David Long with the aim of writing a formal recount.
- **Shakespeare** – Read and study a play by William Shakespeare. Prepare a play that will be performed at the theatre.
- **Beowulf** – Read and discuss Beowulf by Michael Morpugo. Describe settings, characters and atmosphere, integrating dialogue to advance the action.

Science, Computing and DT

- **Earth and Space** – Know about the Earth’s journey around the Sun and the moon’s journey around Earth.
- **Forces** – Explore the theory of gravity and its effect on different objects.
- **Materials** – Study reversible and irreversible changes.
- **Spreadsheets/Databases** - Create simple formulae with different variables and convert measurements.
- **Game Creation** - Design a computer game by manipulating different variables.
- **Towers** – Investigate tall buildings. Design and construct a tower forming joints.

- **Weaving** – Create a representation of a river landscape using textiles.
- **Lowry** - Discuss the features of rural and urban landscapes.
- **Music** - Continue to develop skills on a woodwind or brass instrument and work towards achieving their silver award.

- **Fractions** – Add and subtract fractions; multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers.
